



DOCTOR'S LETTER

To whom it may concern,

I have prescribed Xolair® (omalizumab) to my patient

Patient's name:

Xolair® can be self-administered and comes as pre-filled syringes containing 1 mL or 0.5 mL solution.

To cover his/her individual dose my patient may need to inject several syringes at once. The medicine should be stored between 2°C and 8°C, but can be kept at room temperature (up to 25°C) for up to 4 hours. If necessary, the medicine may be returned to the refrigerator for later use, but this must not be done more than once.

Therefore, my patient may need to transport the medication in the aircraft cabin or in a refrigerator on board.

TRAVEL CHECKLIST

When travelling, there are many things to consider. To make your trip as enjoyable as possible, please adhere to the following travel checklist. Ask your doctor to fill in the form on the left, so you can rest easy.

	 Talk to your doctor and / or pharmacist to make sure you have sufficient Xolair® for your entire trip.
	 Ask your doctor to fill in the form on the left and / or request a copy of your prescription.
	 Ask your pharmacist how unused medicines or waste materials should be disposed of abroad.
	 Transport Xolair® in a cool bag and check if a refrigerator is available at the destination.
	Xolair® should always be stored at 2°C–8°C but may be stored once only for up to 4 hours at room temperature (maximum 25° C).
	 Make sure you also pack administration materials, such as alcohol swabs, cotton balls, band-aids/adhesive plasters and a sharps bin in your luggage.
